The response was overwhelmingly inspiring, with participants ranging from young children to elders over 60 years old. It was truly a heart-warming sight to see the community's eagerness to understand and improve their overall health.

In addition to the check-ups, our team also conducted health awareness sessions, emphasising the importance of regular health check-ups and healthy living practices with the aim to educate the community on managing their health proactively.
