This comprehensive infrastructure enhancement encompasses vital areas, including constructing an art studio stage, concreting school yards, building new restrooms, renovating existing facilities, repairing classroom ceilings, and providing essential furniture for schools. Four schools - SDN007, SDN006, SMPN38, and SDN011 - situated within a 5KM radius of Wasco's base in Batam, boasting a combined student population of 4,000, stand to benefit from this transformative initiative.
