Track Record

Pengerang Deepwater Terminal (PDT) is located at the southern tip of Peninsular Malaysia and it is becoming a regional downstream hub for the oil, gas and petrochemical industries. PDT is also the deepest terminal in the region.

PDT with its unique multiple 24 metres deep water berths enables itself to handle very large crude carriers (VLCC), ultra large crude carriers (ULCC) and liquefied natural gas (LNG) vessels up to Q-Max size.
